Sub:- MACP SCHEME-Clarification in respect of O.M. No.35034/3/2008-  
Estt.(D) dated 16.11.2009 issued by DOP&T-Regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter F.No.211/1/2009-DL/1502 dated 7.4.2010 on the subject mentioned above.

2. The matter has been examined in the light of the recommendations contained in para 2.2.19 (vii) of the report of the 6<sup>th</sup> CPC, provisions contained in para 5 of the Annexure of the MACP Scheme and clarification issued by the DOP&T vide their O.M. No.35034/3/2008-Estt.(D) dated 16<sup>th</sup> November 2009 referred to above. It may be seen that:-

- (i) The scales belonging to Group 'D' viz. Rs. Rs.2550-3200, Rs.2610-3540, Rs.2610-4000 and Rs.2650-4000 have been merged with the entry grade in the pay band PB-1 due to up-gradation of pay scale of Group 'D' employees and their placement as a Group 'C' employee in the grade pay of Rs.1800 in PB-1.
- (ii) In term of para 5 of the MACP Scheme, the promotions earned/up-gradations granted under the ACP Scheme in the past to those grades which now carry the same grade pay due to merger of pay scales/up-gradations of posts recommended by the sixth CPC shall be ignored for the purpose of granting up-gradations under MACP Scheme.
- (iii) Therefore financial up-gradation under MACP Scheme which is effective from 1.1.2009 may be granted to these sets of employees as under:-

Pay Scale	1st financial up-gradation under MACP on completion of 10 years regular service in the Grade Pay	2nd financial up-gradation on completion of 20 years of regular service in the Grade Pay	3rd financial up-gradation on completion of 30 years of regular service in the Grade Pay
Rs.2750-4400 (pre-revised) corresponding to grade pay of Rs.1800	Rs.1900	Rs.2000	Rs.2400
